# **COMMUNITY ART**

## 2019

- A Warm Gesture 2019 City of Fairfax Public Art Program, Stacy C. Sherwood Community Center, Fairfax, Virginia. Artist originated concept, design and proposal. Materials procured and volunteers recruited by artist working in tandem with City of Fairfax Department of Parks and Recreation. Artist organized and directly supervised 2 open community events, resulting in fabrication of 91 scarves, 26 hats and 15 pairs of gloves. Clothing items created were placed on display in public view and will be distributed to the homeless in and around the Nation's Capital in early 2020 after the installation closes. In response to overwhelming feedback from the public, this will be an ongoing community endeavor with installations occurring annually.
- Quilting a Revolution Supported by Arlington Arts Center, Arlington, Virginia. Artist originated concept, design and proposal. Procured materials from supplies destined to be discarded after Arlington Arts Center's City of Threads installation (unaffiliated) closed, equating to (10) 55-gallon size bags of fabric. Recruited and organized small group of volunteers to generate quilts ("solidarity blankets") for distribution to the homeless in the Washington metropolitan area. Materials obtained on June 26, 2019, with internal production deadline of 50 units by December 26, 2019; goal achieved ahead of schedule (on December 2, 2019) while adhering to zero waste initiative. Production is ongoing and will continue until supplies are exhausted. In response to positive feedback from the public and quilt recipients, this effort will likely become an ongoing endeavor.
